Hebrews 2:5



But one testified in a certain place, saying:

“What is man that You are mindful of him, Or the son of man that You take care of him?”

Hebrews 2:6

I was on
His *mind*

*You have made him a
little lower than the
angels; You have
crowned him with
glory and honor,
And set him over the
works of Your hands.*

Hebrews 2:7

He was made
lower than
angels *for me*

You have put all things in subjection under his feet." For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing that is not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him.

Hebrews 2:8

But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

and by whom are all
things, in bringing many
sons to glory, to make
the captain of their
salvation perfect through
sufferings.*

Hebrews 2:10

To bring me
to *salvation*

*For both He who
sanctifies and those
who are being
sanctified are all of one,
for which reason He is
not ashamed to call
them brethren,
Hebrews 2:11*

To bring me
into

His family

*Saying: "I will
declare Your name
to My brethren;
In the midst of the
assembly I will
sing praise to You."*

Hebrews 2:12

*And again: "I will
put My trust in
Him." And again:
"Here am I and the
children whom God
has given Me."*

Hebrews 2:13

*Inasmuch then as
the children have
partaken of flesh
and blood, He
Himself likewise
shared in the
same,*

*that through death
He might destroy
him who had the
power of death,
that is, the devil,*

Hebrews 2:14

*And release those
who through fear
of death were all
their lifetime
subject to
bondage.*

not give aid to

things He had to be
made like His
brethren,*

*that He might be a
merciful and faithful
High Priest in things
pertaining to God, to
make propitiation for
the sins of the
people.*

To be my
priest

*For in that He

suffered, being
tempted, He is able
to aid those who
are tempted.*
