heart

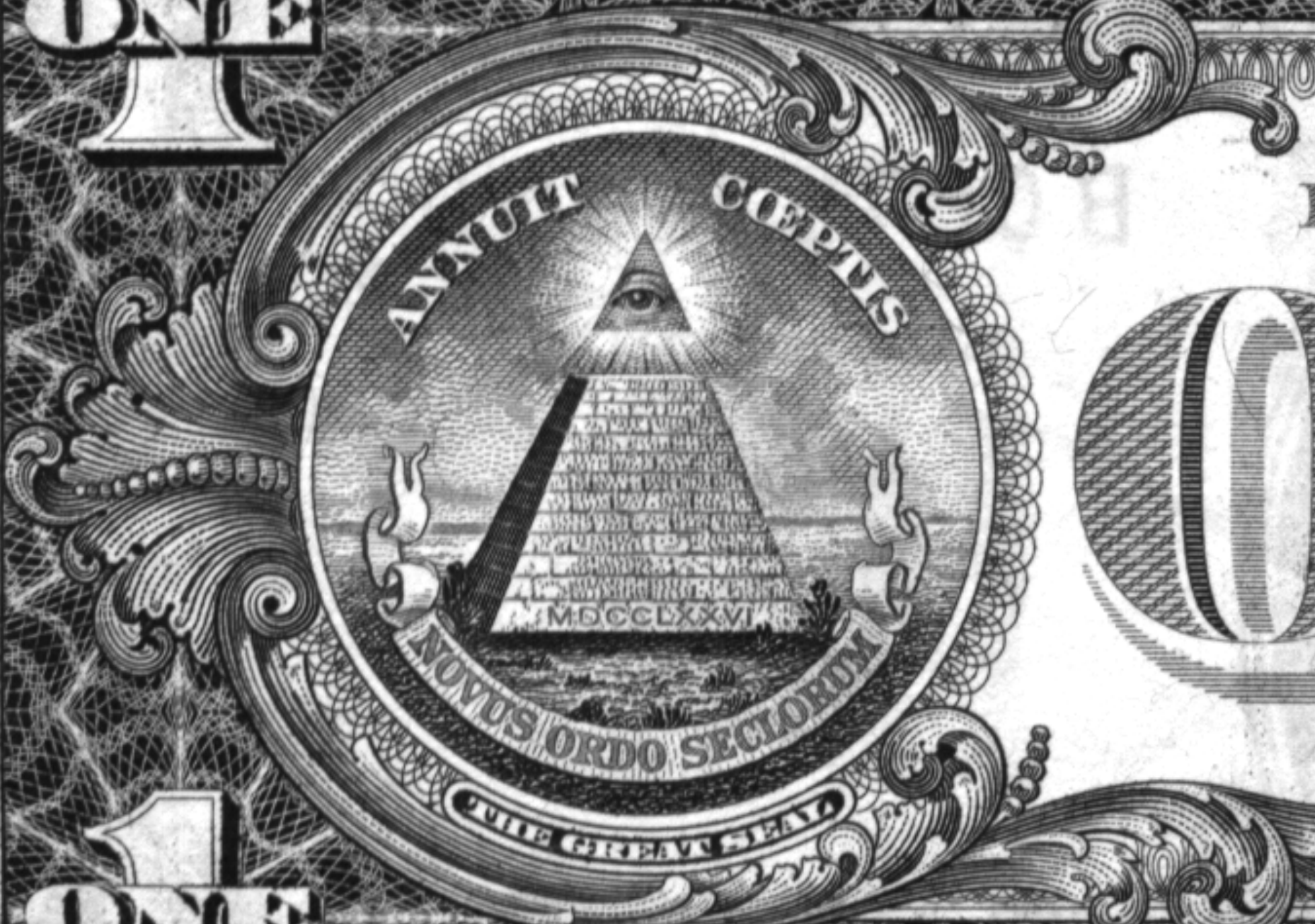

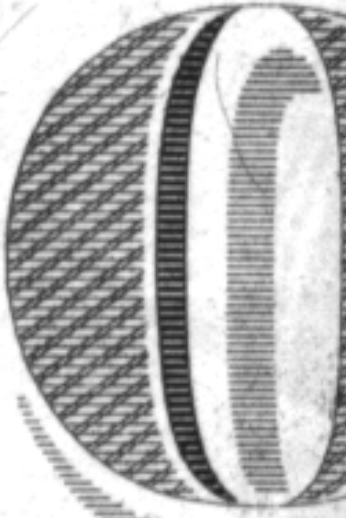
